Please note that, if you are purchasing tickets on behalf of a Red Wall supporters club member, their booking history will not be credited. This could reduce their chances of getting future tickets if we were to implement our loyalty scheme.

In order for a supporters club member to add to their booking history they must quote their membership number whilst booking tickets through the usual channels, i.e. through the FAW website, the FAW booking line or the stadium ticket office (home matches only).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. Tickets are subject to availability and applications will be processed on a first come first served basis.
2. Should applicants be successful, tickets will be issued approximately 2 weeks prior to the match.
3. Tickets are issued on the condition that:
 - a. They will not be used as a prize in any lottery or competition or for any other promotional or advertising purpose unless expressly authorised by the Football Association of Wales Ltd (FAW)
 - b. They will not be re-sold for more than their face value.

If tickets are obtained in breach of these conditions they will be void and all rights conferred or evidenced by them will be nullified.
4. If the match is cancelled or postponed a refund will be available in accordance with the ticket refund policy of the FAW, obtainable from the FAW. If the match is eventually played the tickets will be valid for the later date.
5. Tickets are issued subject to the ground rules of the stadium operator and on condition that none of the FAW, stadium operator and their respective servants and agents will be liable for loss, injury or damage to the ticket holder unless caused by their act or omission.
6. Admission cannot be guaranteed if the ticket holder arrives at the stadium less than 30 minutes before the advertised kick off. If admission is refused no money will be refunded. The ticket holder shall not be entitled to re-admission on leaving the stadium.
7. Entry to the stadium will be denied to any person carrying alcohol, any drink container, laser device, air horn or any article (for example a firework or flag stick) which may be used as a weapon or missile.
