ROAD travel

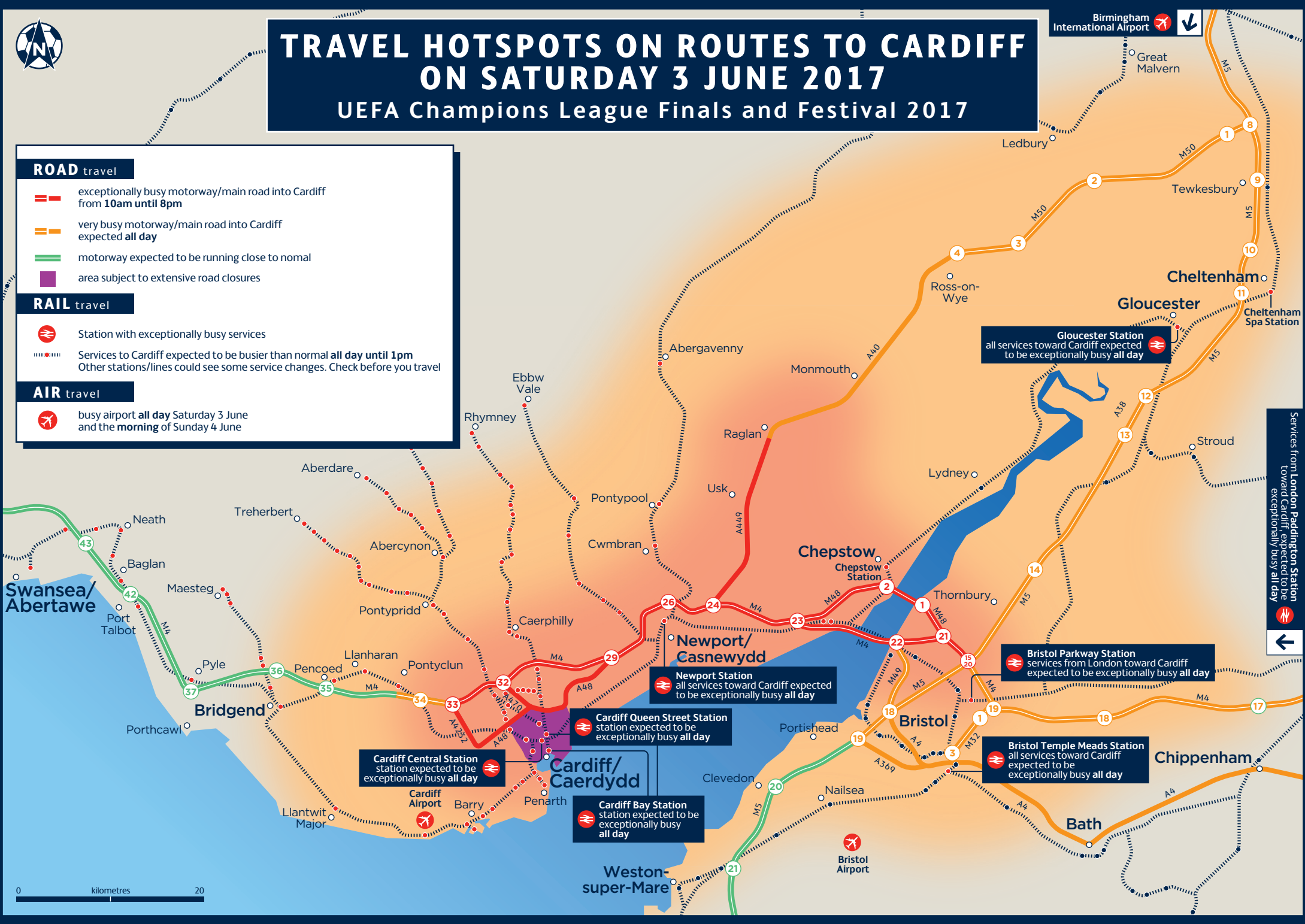
- exceptionally busy motorway/main road into Cardiff from 10am until 8pm
